Jason Lindsay took a fine win today riding from scratch with 3 others - Kim Parslow, Tony McDonald and Mike Stacey.

About 5 groups started the race I think and scratch had pulled them all in by about the 30km mark averaging 41.5kph. Most groups seemed to fall apart not long after getting caught but a few hung on. With about 3 or 4 laps to go there were only 5 riders left - the original 4 scratch riders plus Ian Bridges-Webb who rode a good race, especially the latter part. Stacey and Lindsay each took turns at attacking with Jason getting away for a lap at one stage. Just before he was caught there was a large acceleration in the group behind with Stacey and Parslow getting across the gap to Jason. These three cemented their lead over the last lap with Jason taking a sprint victory (and a long! one at that) from Stacey and Parslow.
