RACE: Club Championships

A near perfect morning for racing with very little wind.

The results for the club championship 90km event are listed under A grade below but riders from A, B and C grade contested the race. There were separate races for D grade and E grade also and those results are listed under their grade categories.

A GRADE

The club championships were held last Sunday morning with around 40 riders signing on. The pace was quick (41kph) overall and this combined with the easy nature of the course and large bunch prevented the opportunists from getting away.

A number tried to escape the herd like bunch but were usually only away for a lap at the most. The last 15-20km were ridden at an average speed of 43.5kph thanks to the efforts of the front 10 riders or so. There were many riders simply hanging on during this part of the race but again, the lack of real "terrain" kept it all together until the last lap.

Going over the small bridge on the back straight during the last lap someone touched the railing and a few riders came down and nearly everyone behind had to stop then get going again. The front riders took advantage and accelerated away for the last half a lap. This front group then underwent another small split with three riders getting clear for the victory.
